



EXPLANATION FOR NUMBERING ROAD INTERSECTIONS

The system used for numbering road intersections is to start "0" at the intersection of E. & W. and N. & S. blue dotted lines any road intersection that is 1 mile north of the E. & W. dotted line would be 100N -- any road intersection 2 miles north of blue dotted line would be 200N. Intermediate intersections would be proportionate parts of 100 (150N). Any intersections 1 mile east of N. & S. dotted line would be 100E -- 2 miles East of dotted line would be 200E. Numbers on map and ground are identical.
